We welcome decorations from our community members too. More info coming soon as to how you can get involved!

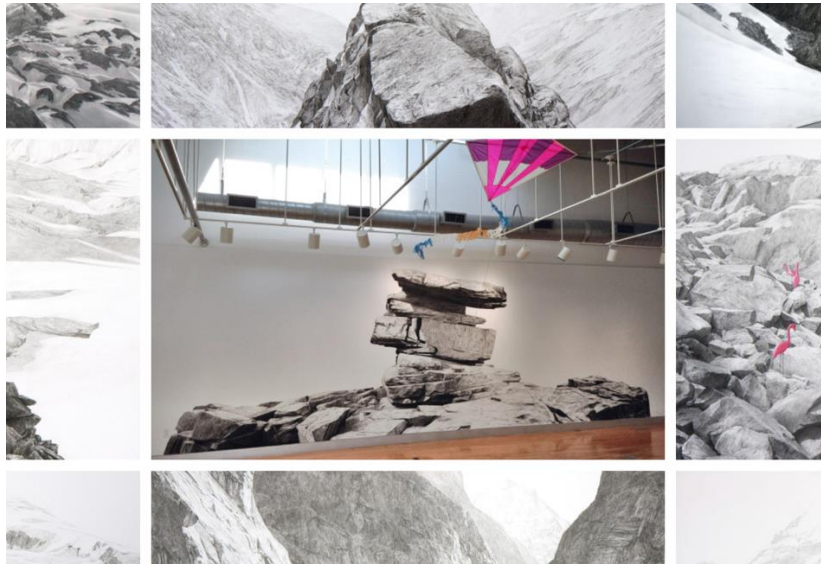


Nexus Mural
