Munich International School (MIS) is a K-12, non-profit, International Baccalaureate World School offering the Primary Years, Middle Years and Diploma Programmes to 1317 students. All courses are offered in English (except language-specific courses) and 95% of students take the full IB Diploma*. Virtually all MIS students pursue four-year undergraduate degrees at selective universities around the world. MIS does not rank students or calculate GPA.

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Curriculum Highlights

- Most MIS students pursue the full IB Diploma. The IB Diploma requires completion of six academic subjects over two years, and Theory of Knowledge.
- All IB Diploma candidates complete a 4,000 word Extended Essay research paper in Grade 12.
- IB courses in Geography, Integrated Humanities and Global Politics include a significant emphasis on history and current events.
- Some students opt instead to take certificates in IB subjects or to receive the MIS Diploma.
- Grade 10 students register for the IB MYP eAssessment and online portfolios.
- Coordinated Science in 9th and 10th grade is an integrated laboratory science course covering Biology, Chemistry and Physics. Students who elect Extended Science go into more depth in all three science topics in both theory and additional lab work.
- All grade 11 Math students covered concepts and topics in Vectors.

Accreditation

MIS is authorised by the IBO, recognised by the Bavarian Ministry of Education, and fully accredited by the Council of International Schools (CIS) and the New England Association of Schools and Colleges (NEASC).



IB Diploma Programme

IB Subjects are graded on a 1-7 scale with 7 being the highest score. A maximum of 45 points can be earned in the IB Diploma.

IB Diploma Results of Class of 2023

- IB Diploma pass rate = 100% (World average pass rate = 79,6%)
- 97% of the grades in all subjects were 4 or above
- 92% of MIS subjects were above the IB world average score
- 22% of the grades were a perfect 7
- 26 % earned a total of 40 points or over
- Average Diploma Points: 36 (World Average: 30.2)
- 1 MIS student achieved a perfect IB Diploma score of 45 points
- 19% earned an A on the Extended Essay
- 9,8% earned an A in TOK

LEARNING BEYOND THE CLASSROOM

At MIS we believe that experiences outside the classroom help make education relevant and greatly support students' decisions about higher education and career choices that best suit their skills and aspirations. These include:

- Grade 10 national and international work experience (3 weeks in June). Full time internships in businesses and non-profits large and small.
- Community Service is an important part of the curriculum at MIS. Students engage on and off campus.
- MIS students support many projects locally and around the world, such as our Tanzania programme, UNICEF, Amnesty International, and community engagement in the greater Munich area.
- Student Life Programme: Over 100 activities for students from Junior School through Grade 12: Performing Arts, Speech and Debate, Robotics, Duke of Endinburgh, Model United Nations, and myriad Sports, just to name a few!
- MIS' Makers' Space is used by all grade levels and supports initiatives in design and audio visual production, fabric arts, sustainability, laser cutting and 3D printing.
- School trips are held for educational and cultural enrichment.
- Special endowment funds enable us to bring in visiting scholars, artists, and adventurers from around the world to speak with students in assemblies and in small groups.
