YOUR ROLE

The Continuing Classroom Supervisor (Substitute) works under the direction of a qualified and approved teacher. Lesson plans or intended activities are provided to the Continuing Classroom Supervisor by the school section office. The Continuing Classroom Supervisor welcomes students, takes attendance, provides instructions and guidance to students, supports them during lessons, and ensures that a safe, learning-conducive environment is maintained for all students at all times. The Continuing Classroom Supervisor must be familiar with MIS protocols and rules, including with relevant student and teacher handbooks, the MIS emergency procedures manual, and MIS Community Commitments to Principled and Ethical Conduct. The Continuing Classroom Supervisor is an important member of the school's educational team for ensuring that student learning can continue even when students' regular teacher is away from school.

YOUR KEY RESPONSIBILITIES

The Continuing Classroom Supervisor . . .

- comes to school each day prepared to supervise students in lessons in which the regular classroom teacher is absent,
- supervises students both in classroom settings and in other typical situations around campus and ensures that students are safe, that they behave in ways consistent with the school's values and rules, and that any dangerous or concerning situations are reported quickly and thoroughly,
- follows the lesson plans or instructions of the regular teacher carefully and ensures that student learning can continue in the teacher's absence,
- maintains an orderly, safe, and focused environment for learning and alerts the school section office to any unusual, unsafe, or disruptive behaviour,
- is prepared to contribute to any day trips, planned activities, and other situations that may arise as part of the schedule for the class they are supervising,
- provides a short written summary for the regular teacher regarding students' progress, and any challenges or unusual occurances.

- Desire to work with children and adolescents and to embody the school's values of care, respect, integrity, and trust.
- Education, training, or experience in the fields of education, childcare, or social work (ideal candidates have a full qualification as a teacher).
